- 128 children living with physical disabilities participated in the Learn to Ride Program in 2022
- The average cost of an adapted bike is \$2,500.00
- · In 2023, **256 participants** received a new bike through the Adapted Bike Program, with 497 members total participating in the program
- 2024 will be the 25th year of CP Kids and Families' Adapted Bike Program
- · Annually, the Adapted Bike Program costs \$250,000.00 · CP Kids & Families has 170 active volunteers to operate

- There are approximately **600 adapted bicycles** in the Adapted Bike Program
- · CP Kids & Families was established in 1951 and now has over 900 members
- · There are almost 200 pieces of adapted equipment in the equipment loan program
- 75 families took part in our Adapted Adventure Library Adventure days in summer 2023
